S = Scripture

Write It!

O = Observation

Think It!

What do you think God was saying to the people He wrote the book to? Rewrite the Scripture in your own words. Consult your commentary for help.

A = Application

Live It!

Personalize what you've read by asking yourself how it applies to your life. Is it an instruction? An encouragement? A promise? A call to take corrective action?
Write how this Scripture applies to you

P = Prayer

Say It!

Your prayer can be as simple as asking God to help you use this Scripture, praising him for something He's done, or confessing a sin. Write it out, just like you would an email, text or letter.
Then live it out!
